'The Hermit Bookstore', set in California's Gold Country, was named 2015 Finalist, fiction category, by TISBA

SACRAMENTO, Calif. — Linda Westphal, bestselling author of feel-good stories, was awarded The Indie Spiritual Book Awards' (TISBA) 2015 Finalist nomination in the fiction category.
